From the Principal...



KICE highlights in 2016 were many and varied. Below are some of our major achievements in 2016.

- Of the 122 SACE grades there were 2 A+, 28 As and 67 Bs. This is a marked improvement.
- 12 students used a Cert III to achieve their SACE and 10 used a Cert III to get their ATAR.
- KICE achieved a higher percentage of students demonstrating DECD Standard of Educational Achievement (SEA).
- The Early Years and Junior Primary Running Records shows growth of over 10 % for the individual cohort of students moving from year 1 to year 2.
- Improved processes to store and record student assessment data in a centralised electronic location.
- Improvement in facilities at every campus, including new Preschool build at Parndana.
- Parndana Preschool exceeds National Benchmarks in National Quality Assurance Audit.
- KICE became a outreach program linking with a DECD music focus school

ATTENDANCE

Attendance at KICE in 2016 was above the DECD average of 90.2%. Parndana Pre-school has shown continuous improvement in attendance, improving from 70.7% in 2014 to 90.8% in 2016.

All but four year levels had above 90% attendance with Years 5 and 7 sitting above 93%.



BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

There has been a significant decrease in the number of behaviour management cases experienced at KICE. The comparison of incidents between 2015-2016 is listed below.

- Early Years - 384 down from 441
- Middle Years - 231 down from 442
- Senior Years - 75 down from 111

This data shows that we had 304 fewer behavioural incidents in 2016 than in 2015.

The allocation of a counsellor at each campus (KICE funded), the introduction of a new FLO program and the implementation of a Middle Years camps program all have supported student wellbeing and engagement.
