Term 1 Week 1-5	<p>Folio Development - Industry and Work Knowledge Topic 4: Career Planning Industry Investigation Building on their knowledge of their chosen industry from work in the PLP, students will research key current labour market statistics and job prospects for their chosen industry area. Students will prepare a set of interview questions and interview a person who has been working in this industry for at least 10 years, to get a sense of changes to the industry and key factors impacting this industry at the current time. Students will reflect on their research giving consideration to how this information has impacted their thinking about the suitability of work in this industry for their own future pathway.</p> <p>Performance Students begin 25-30 hours of work placement or negotiated VET activity, developing an electronic personal profile of evidence.
