**BULLYING IS .....**

**deliberate, hurtful gestures, words or actions which are repeated over time.**

*It can be a criminal offence if there is physical violence or threats. Anyone over the age of 10 years may be dealt with by the police.*

<b>Non-Verbal</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Threatening and/or obscene gestures/body language</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deliberate exclusion from a group or activity</li> <li>• Removing and hiding and/or damaging others belongings</li> </ul>
<b>Cyber-bullying</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Threatening and /or obscene photos/text.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Photos/text sent with the intent to ridicule</li> </ul>

**The School Community will:**

- Promote students' sense of concern and responsibility.
- Develop skills and strategies to deal with bullying.
- Provide positive role models
- Build self esteem and resilience
- Keep the lines of communication open
- Share information

### **If you are being bullied you can:**

- Tell them to stop and walk away
- Find a friend/group to join
- Ignore them and report it
- Walk away and report it
- Tell someone who will help you

### **If you see someone being bullied you can:**

- Tell the person bullying to stop
- Be a friend to the person being bullied
- Seek help

### **What do we do to reduce bullying**

#### **Prevention strategies include:**

- Promoting the values of respect, responsibility, honesty, care and Doing your Best.
- Teach Social Skills programs R-12.
- Provide professional learning to staff

#### **Intervention strategies include:**

- Counselling students involved in bullying
- Talking with parents and caregivers about the situation and strategies
- Putting consequences in place for those who bully others
- Ensuring all staff know how to address bullying effectively and respectfully

#### **Ongoing strategies include:**

- Monitoring the situation between the students to ensure their safety and wellbeing are maintained
- Reviewing our yard duty procedures to make sure they are effective
- Dealing with 'hotspots' in the yard
- Reviewing and evaluating behaviour codes and policies

## **BULLYING INTERVENTION PROCEDURE**

**Bullying occurs**



**Staff informed**



Consequence will include:

• **Formal warning**

OR

• **Relocation (from Yard or Class)**

OR

• **Internal suspension**

OR

• **External suspension**

**Re-entry process**

- Counselling will be ongoing throughout the process.
- Parents of all students involved will be informed about reported bullying incidents and consequences.
